All events will be held as signed up for - no one will be asked to move to the next lower age division. Pool length: 25 yards. Department Division rules apply. Awards: 1st, 2nd & 3rd place medals as well as High Point awards for all categories offered. Relays do not count towards the High Point award. Order of events: 200 Free Relay, 400 Free, 100 Breast, 50 Back, 25 Free, 100 Fly, 50 Free, 100 IM, 50 Breast, 100 Free, 200 IM, 100 Back, 50 Fly and 200 Free. Pool / Timing: 8 lane, 25 yard short course, heated, outdoor pool. Separate warm-up/warm-down lanes available during competition. Colorado Timing System® and Hy-Tek Meet Manager software will be used for timing/scoring.

Eligibility: All full-time sworn law enforcement, full-time certified correctional officers, retired-sworn law enforcement, retired-correctional officers, retired-firefighter, Reservist I from municipality, county, federal or state agencies are eligible to participate and paid full-time professional firefighters. Those who can not participate are: Persons employed as security guards, police students, military personal, volunteer fire personal and police cadets.

Rules: Current USMS Swimming and Florida Gold Coast rules will govern this meet. Safety rules as outlined by USMS Swimming and as recommended by the referee, will be in effect.

Disability: All swimmers are welcome at this meet! Any athlete with a disability will be accommodated.

Entry Limit: Swimmers may swim a maximum of 4 individual events and 1 relay.

Seeding: Eligible entries will be seeded by sex and age group.

Timed Finals: All events are Timed Finals

Awards: Individual Medals: 1st – 3rd (High point for each age group Male and Female)

Scoring: 4-2-1, relays will not count towards individual high point awards.
